High School applicants must have a minimum of a 3.00 cumulative GPA during their senior year and adults must have a minimum of a 3.50 cumulative GPA for all career training classes completed at the WCSCC. Preference will be given to female applicants who demonstrate financial need, motivation to succeed and are pursuing education in career technologies other than the majors listed below.

The following majors **do not qualify** for this scholarship:

Associate of Applied Science Degree Major in Horse Production and Management  
Associate of Applied Science Degree Major in Floral Design and Marketing  
Associate of Science Degree Major of Horse Science

This is a renewable scholarship for one additional consecutive year, based on recipient(s) maintaining a 3.00 cumulative GPA, being enrolled as a full-time student taking at least 12 hours per term, and being in good standing at OSU-ATI.
