This scholarship is available to a Wayne County resident. The criteria for this award is divided into two categories: the traditional student, who is currently in high school, and the non-traditional student.

Traditional Student (applying as a high school senior):

- A. Graduating from Wayne County Schools
- B. Cumulative grade point average of 3.00 or above
- C. Accepted candidate to a Licensed Practical Nurse or Registered Nurse (associate degree, diploma, baccalaureate or advanced degree) program.

Non-Traditional Student

- A. Current resident in Wayne County, working in Wayne County or in school in Wayne County.
- B. Proof of potential academic achievement (standardized testing, nursing pretests, cumulative grade point average, etc.)
- C. Accepted candidate in a Licensed Practical Nursing, Registered Nursing or advance nursing degree program.

- A personal letter describing in no more than two pages your interest in nursing and why you should receive the award.
- At least 2 letters of academic reference. Additional personal references may also be included.
- A resume or a list of the extra-curricular activities in which you have participated. Note the position held, honors or awards received, and dates of involvement.
- A transcript of your grades from high school, including ACT or SAT scores.
- Additional supporting information, if applicable.

Non-traditional students should include the following with this application:

- A personal letter describing in no more than two pages your interest in nursing and why you should receive the award.
- At least 2 letters of academic or professional references. Additional personal references may also be included.
- A resume or curriculum vitae.
- A transcript of your grades from college, nursing program or nursing pre-test scores.
- Additional supporting information, if applicable.
