Applicant must have battled, or had an immediate family member who battled, breast cancer.
Arden and Clarice Shisler Nationwide Insurance Scholarship	Current graduating seniors of Dalton High School who have a balance of participation in academics, extracurricular activities, and community service or part-time employment. Must have a minimum of a 2.50 GPA and demonstrate financial need. First preference shall be granted to students enrolling in a higher educational institution located in the State of Ohio or those pursing a major in any agriculture or agriculture related field.
Benjamin E. Moody Scholarship	Student who graduated from a Wayne County high school or has lived in Wayne County for five years. The student must be following a course of study in law enforcement.
